Dinghy Dock Rules

Dinghy storage docks are located at various locations through the marina for use of storing dinghies out of the water. The docks are wooden floats attached to the side of the concrete docks at the following locations:

- Dinghy Dock A – located on the back side of A-dock between slips A-18 to A-21
- Dinghy Dock C – located adjacent to the finger of slip C-0
- Dinghy Dock D – located adjacent to the finger of slip D-01
- Dinghy Dock P – located on both sides at the far end of the pumpout dock

Space on the dinghy docks is limited and is reserved as follows:

1. Slip owners have the 1st right of refusal to space on the dinghy docks
2. Seasonal renters may reserve space on the dinghy docks as is available.
3. Priority for seasonal renters will be based on seniority (# of years at Caswell Cove)
4. Spaces on the dinghy docks will be assigned by the marina manager based on dinghy size, slip location, and the order in which reservations are received.
5. There is no guarantee that enough spaces are available for all members

The rules for usage of the dinghy docks are as follows:

1. Use of the dinghy docks is reserved for inflatable dinghies and RIBs only
2. Weight of dinghy and motor cannot exceed 250 lbs
3. The dinghy cannot overhang the dock to which it is fastened or impede access on any of the docks or fingers
4. Dinghies cannot exceed 11 feet in length
5. Dinghies must be tied down by the bow to the cleat (provided)
6. Dinghies will be assigned to specific locations and those assigned spaces cannot be used by other members
7. You may not reserve a dinghy space for another member or friend. The dinghy must be registered in the name of the slip owner or renter to whom the space is assigned.
8. All dinghies must be in good condition and maintained in fully inflated condition – dinghies shall not be filled with trash or junk
9. No fueling of dinghies on the dinghy docks or anywhere in the marina
10. Personal items shall not be stored on any of the dinghy docks or fingers
